

Instructions on using starter regions (Windows):

1. Copy the **Medium City.zip** zip file to your **My Documents** folder (or in Windows Vista, **Documents** folder) on the computer you plan to use SimCity 4 on. Please do this from the user you plan to play SimCity 4 with.
2. Uncompress the zip file you copied over. In Windows XP or Windows Vista, you should be able to double-click the file.
 - a. If you have Windows Compression turned on, it will open it up like a folder. On the left hand pane, select **Extract files** and it should extract it to **My Documents** folder.
 - b. If you have a zip utility (such as WinZip or PKZip) installed, please follow that programs stand extraction instructions.
3. Locate the folder you just extracted, it will be named **Medium City**.
4. Copy the folder to the **My Documents\SimCity 4\Regions** directory for the user you plan to play SimCity 4 with. You should end up with the following directory:
 - **My Documents\SimCity 4\Regions\Medium City**
5. Now start SimCity 4. When you reach the region view, select Load Region. Select the **Medium City** Region
6. Your region should look similar to the following:
 - a. Medium City -



7. Please determine what you want to name your competition city. Once you start your city, you can NOT change your city's name. We need the name of the city to match your submission paperwork to make scoring easier.
8. Start your new city on the square in the center of the existing cities. They are labeled **Design (City Size) City HERE** in the pictures above.
9. You can delete and create a new city if you are unhappy with your existing city. You can via Windows folder structure navigate to the **My Documents\SimCity 4\Regions** folder, select the region folder, and copy your city file to another directory on your computer if you want to backup the city.

Instructions on using starter regions (MAC):

1. Download the **Medium City.zip** file to your computer. It will store them in the **Data\Downloads** directory and it will unzip the file for you. Please execute this download on the computer you plan to use SimCity 4 on. Please do this from the user you plan to play SimCity 4 with.
2. Open up Finder and open up the **Data** folder. Locate the folder you just extracted, it will be named **Medium City**.
3. Copy the folder to the **SimCity 4 Deluxe\SimCity 4 Data\Regions** directory for the user you plan to play SimCity 4 with. You should end up with the following directory:
- **SimCity 4 Deluxe\SimCity 4 Data\Regions\Medium City**
4. Now start SimCity 4. When you reach the region view, select Load Region. Select the **Medium City** region.
5. Your region should look similar to the following:
 - a. Medium City -



6. Please determine what you want to name your competition city. Once you start your city, you can NOT change your city's name. We need the name of the city to match your submission paperwork to make scoring easier.
